



# Wisconsin QSO Party 2021 Results



## Summary

2021 was another record-breaking year for the Wisconsin QSO party. Participation was up once again, this year by 96 entries. As we move closer to solar maximum, 40 meters is behaving as we would expect. In-state propagation is improving on 40 with 80 meters coming alive a bit later. In another year or two we should see 80 and 40 meters swap the bread-and-butter band positions. Weather was favorable with mild temps and no significant precipitation.

Two standing records were broken in 2021, Single Op Fixed (SOF) and Multi-Op Mobile (MOM). Coincidentally, both records were broken by the previous record holders. Chad Kurszewski, WE9V, broke his old SOF record score of 207,009 points set in 2014 with 207,654 points logged this year. Scott Jasper, NE9U, shattered his old MOM record score of 221,652 points set in 2013 by logging 233,580 points in 2021. 2016 was the last time any standing record was broken. Nice job!

Congratulations to all the winners!

## WIQP 2021

2021 was another record breaking year for log submissions. We received 542 logs, a new record and 96 more than the previous year. This is up 22% over 2020 and a whopping 64% over 2019. Wisconsin stations submitted 175 logs this year, 17 more than last year, up 11%. Non-Wisconsin stations accounted for the majority of the increased participation. 367 logs were submitted from outside Wisconsin, up 27%.

The state QSO Party challenge, new in 2020, continues to play a significant role in the 2021 uptick. Being one of the QSO Parties early in the cycle, along with early Spring weather undoubtedly helps the cause.

### County Activation

Logs reported QSOs sent from 68 of 72 counties. The missing counties were in the Northeastern corner, Florence, Forest, Menominee, and Shawano. 71 counties have reports of QSOs received. Only Menominee County has no reported QSOs.

What an opportunity for mobiles and rovers! These counties are the perfect QTH for starting a pileup. We need mobiles and rovers to help stimulate the low activity counties. Any fixed stations that have not jumped in would have a fun afternoon ahead as well.

In 2021, 22 counties were activated only by mobiles, up a bit from 18 last year but trending up since 2019. Since mobile routes through counties have not changed dramatically, local ham operation may have fallen off. Overall, mobile QSOs were reported in 59 counties, so their contribution continues to be very significant--mobiles characterize state QSO parties. Thanks to everyone who makes the extra effort to get on the road for our party!

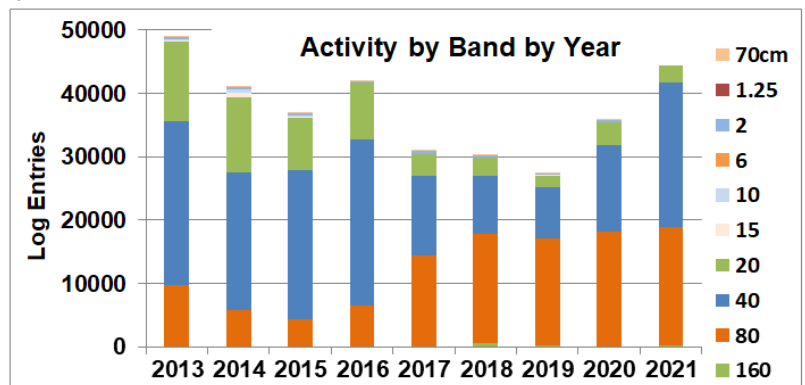
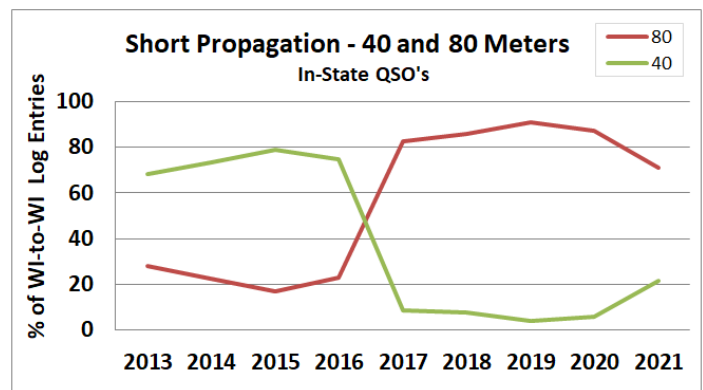
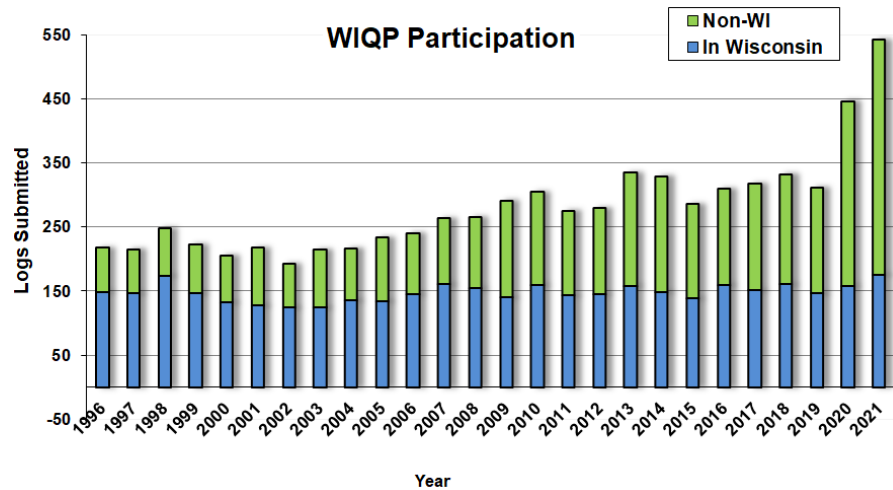
As in recent years, WIQP county activation data will be put on the website after the results are published.

### Activity by Band

Since 2017 we have experienced a long 40 meter phenomenon limiting the usefulness of the band for the WI QSO Party. As we approach solar maximum, we are starting to see 40 meters shorten up again.

If extrapolated, the propagation chart on the right is trending for the lines to cross in 2022. Be prepared for improved short propagation on 40 meters. The analysis should prove interesting as a complete solar cycle of data builds.

The Activity by Band chart to the right also demonstrates the increased log entries. It is noteworthy that much of the increased volume this year is represented by 40 meter QSOs.



## Category Results

### Single Op Rookie (SOR)

Seventeen Rookie logs were received from Wisconsin stations this year compared to eleven last year. Fifteen Rookie logs were received from outside the state.

This year's top Rookie is Fred Schwierske, W9KEY, of Cedarburg in Ozaukee County, with 47,520 points on 528 phone Q's. The second place Rookie is Wayne Mueller, W1QC, of Oshkosh in Winnebago County. Wayne scored 34,569 points on 244 CW and phone QSO's operating from Oneida County.

Rookie entries were up significantly overall from seventeen last year to thirty-two this year. Thanks to all the Rookies for entering WIQP! We hope you had fun and will be back next year.

The Rookie category, as the name implies, is to encourage newcomers to get involved and join the fun. Entrants do not need to be new hams--just new to WIQP. The Rookie category is available to new entrants for two consecutive years--see Rules for details. All entrants in this category receive a certificate.

### Single Op Fixed (SOF)

Chad Kurszewski, WE9V, in Kenosha County once again takes the top spot with 207,654 points on 830 total Q's. Runner-up is Steve Franzen, N9CK, who rose to the occasion logging 533 CW Q's for a score of 153,504. Steve operated from McFarland in Dane County.

Congratulations Chad and Steve, and thanks to all 136 SOF entries from Wisconsin stations.

### Multi-Op Fixed (MOF)

Again this year, husband/wife team of Joe and Linda Mayenschein, WB9SBD and KA9CHM, operating W9ET as the Driftless Zone Contesters took the top spot in this category with 111,340 points on 563 QSO's. Linda and Joe operated from Sauk County near LaValle.

Second place in this category is awarded to Bruce Richardson, W9FZ, and Janice Hoettels, KA9VVQ. They scored 99,476.5 points with a total of 482 QSO's operating from Vernon County near Hillsboro.

Congratulations to both of the above groups and thanks to all eight MOF entries for your efforts!

### Multi-Multi Fixed (MMF)

There were three entries in this group, up from one last year. Top honors go to the Mississippi Valley Amateur Radio Association, turning in a score of 202,014 points on 914 Q's. Making up their team was Scott Neader, KA9FOX, Craig Goldbeck, N9ETD, William Kleinschmidt, N9FDE, and Tom Speropulos, WA9TS.

Second in this category is the team of Bob Schmidt, N9GMT, Steve Sundquist, N9FSE, Emil Devcic, N9FBB, and Christopher Rozman, KD9JAI. They scored 28,872 points on 248 Q's.

Thanks to these two teams as well as Paul Hughes' group, W9CBJ, in this category!

### Single-Op Mobile (SOM)

There were seven Single-Op mobiles this year and three MOMs. The MMM category did not have any entries.

Patrick Cain, K0PC, lead the pack of SOMs with a score of 218,578. Patrick covered 17 counties racking up a total of 1,061 CW Q's with 66 mults. An effort was made to cover Wisconsin's mid-section. His 17 county route started in CLA and strategically moved Southeast to WIN and FON before looping back to the west. At MON, Patrick headed north to EAU and then westward to STC exiting the state toward his Minnesota home.

This year there was a total of three Minnesota mobiles. They do a great job of covering some of the lower activity counties in Western Wisconsin. We welcome and appreciate your participation. Thank you!

### Multi-Op Mobile (MOM)

Notably missed this year is K8IR/m. Jim has been a long standing mobile op in the Wisconsin QSO Party, activating several Northeastern counties.

Once again, Scott Jasper, NE9U, and Al Schlaugat, N9ISN, ran Multi-Op Mobile and scored 233,580 points (142,292 last year) with 963 Q's on CW and 44 on phone for a total of 1,007 Q's, winning the category.

Scott and Al covered 18 counties which no doubt had a carefully planned route. They started in MRN, moved south to BRO, and added a loop to cover DOO and KEW. Continuing South, the team covered the lakeshore counties to OZA and then proceeded to head back north on the west side of Lake Winnebago to OUT. The final leg took them Southwest ending the party in MAR.

### Multi-Multi Mobile (MMM)

No MMM entries were submitted this year. Perhaps the pandemic may have discouraged ops from getting together at this level. Let's look toward more activity in this category for '22.

### Top Non-Wisconsin Single-Op

This year's out-of-state honors and the Top Non-WI plaque go Craig Thompson, K9CT, in Illinois. Craig scored 28,995 points on 298 Q's. David Pritchard, W9QL, also in Illinois, is this year's runner-up with 28,177.5 points on 217 QSO's.

The number of logs from outside Wisconsin was way up this year – 367 compared to 288 in 2020. Congratulations to all the participating non-Wisconsin hams. We enjoy hosting and invite you back next year!

### Top QRP Station

Joel Kluender, W9JFK, secured the top position in the QRP ranks for a second consecutive year. Operating from Grant county, he earned 77,958 points on 279 QSO's, mostly on CW. Second place goes to Dan Alwin, KE0TT, from Minnesota operating mobile in Wisconsin. Dan scored 49,128 points on 189 Q's.

Eleven QRP stations submitted logs compared to twelve last year. Seven are from out of state.

### Top VHF Station

The VHF plaque has a 500 point minimum and Brian Long, KB9LRD/ mobile, had no problem surpassing the milestone. Brian logged 104 VHF QSO's and 12 mults for 4,872 VHF points travelling through 8 counties in East-central Wisconsin.

Second place is awarded to Justin Kurscheidt, operating a fixed station from Calumet County. Justin worked 41 Q's with 9 mults for a total score of 1,053.5 points.

Fifty-four stations reported 654 VHF/UHF QSO's in 2021, ten more ops than last year. Two meter phone appears to be the band of choice commanding 587 QSOs logged, with 65 Q's on 70 cm, and 2 on six meters. All QSOs were on phone except for 1 CW on six meters.

### Club Competition

The West Allis Radio Amateur Club takes top honors in the club competition this year with an aggregate score of 311,947.5 points contributed by 17 members. Top scorers were Ron Gorski, N9AU, and Al Hovey, WA9BZW, both operating SOF stations.

The second place club is the Ozaukee Radio Club with 274,716 points contributed by 11 members. Top scorers were Vic Shier, WT9Q, and Fred Schwierske, W9KEY, operating as a second year rookie!

2021 was an inaugural year with the roll-out of a WIQP promotion campaign, presented at multiple club's meetings. Thanks to the clubs that hosted us as well as all the clubs who promoted WIQP to their members.

### W9FK Bonus

The West Allis club call, W9FK, was activated again by Phil Gural, W9NAW, from his home station in Waukesha County. Phil intended to go portable again this year, but due to the Covid constraints, it wasn't feasible. 303 phone QSO's were made for 35,905.5 points. Note that the W9FK activity is listed under "WARAC Bonus Station--W9FK" in the club listing and is not included in the West Allis Club aggregate. Thanks to Phil for being W9FK for a day.

## Log Submissions

Log submissions were almost completely electronic this year, either through direct email or the use of the WA7BNM Cabrillo Web Form. Adding the web form last year had a major impact on reducing the number of paper logs submitted. Thanks again to Bruce for providing the tool. With the growth of 200 entries over the past two years, managing any volume of paper submissions would be a daunting task. And if you don't usually send in your log, please consider doing so. We want your logs!
