- One of the shortest QSO parties—only 7 hours long
- Mobiles, rovers, and portables vital to QSO party interest & success
- Sponsored by WARAC since 1979

- Scoring: CW: 2 pts Dig: 2 pts Phone: 1 pt
 - Mults: Counties, St & Prov worked
- Power Level Multiplier: HP:1 LP: 1.5 QRP: 2

Wisconsin QSO Party 2022 Results

many

2022 saw a decrease in log entries with 450 logs submitted vs. 542 logs last year. Out-of-state participation came in at 53 entries less and in-state at 39 entries less. Several factors may have contributed, Covid fatigue, the threat of a CME headed towards earth and terrestrial weather. Weather across the state differed considerably. While much of the state enjoyed good winter conditions, the northwest was impacted making mobile operations difficult and shortened operations for those operating at a secondary QTH in northwest Wisconsin. Typically this part of the state is covered by mobiles from our Minnesota comrades.
