

# Wisconsin QSO Party 2024 Results



#### **Summary**

Mother nature did not disappoint. The 2024 WI QSO party had favorable conditions on multiple fronts—propagation, weather, and the number of participants. 532 logs were received compared to 501 last year. Submissions from outside Wisconsin totaled 334, an increase from 296 and in-state submissions amount to 198, a slight decrease from 205 in 2023. The overall increase in log submissions is attributed to entries from outside Wisconsin. Terrestrial weather was excellent across the entire state. Weather plays a significant impact with getting our sparsely populated Northwestern counties activated. Thanks to the Minnesota mobiles for assisting with activating these counties.


#### Plaque Winners

#### **WIQP 2024**

532 logs were received, up 6% over 2023. Wisconsin stations submitted 198 logs, down 3%. Non-Wisconsin stations submitted 334 logs, up 13%.



#### **County Activation**

Logs received reported QSOs sent from 69 of Wisconsin's 72 counties. No logs were received from stations operating in Florence, Forest, or Lafayette counties. 70 counties have reports of QSOs logged. Florence and Forest County seem to be absent of any reported QSOs. Once again, all 50 states had QSO activity. Additionally, four DX logs were received representing Germany, Poland, Slovak Republic, and Norway. 101 unique DX call signs were logged overall representing 478 QSO's.


Nineteen counties were activated only by mobiles. This is up by nine compared to 2023. Typically, many Northwestern counties are activated by mobiles only. Last year's poor winter driving conditions in that part of the state led to numerous counties with no coverage. Although we were back to our customary activity this year, we would like to see more hams in the rare counties get on the air. The 19 mobile counties--Ashland, Bayfield, Burnett, Clark, Iron, Jackson, Juneau, Lincoln, Menominee, Monroe, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, Rusk, Sawyer, Taylor, Trempealeau, Washburn, and Waupaca.


Mobiles have characterized the Wisconsin QSO party and continue to make it the event it is today. Thanks to all 25 mobiles for participating this year!

#### **Activity by Band**

The in-state propagation on 40 and 80 meters is correlating well with the solar cycle. As we approach the solar maximum, 40 meters outperforms 80 meters. If predictions are correct, cycle 25 should surpass what we saw in cycle 24. With the significant growth in out-of-state participation since 2020 and an approaching solar peak, let's not forget to check 10 and 15 meters for openings.

#### **Category Results**





#### Single Op Rookie (SOR)

Twenty-two Rookie logs were received from Wisconsin stations this year compared to twenty-one last year. Ten Rookie logs were received from outside the state giving us a total of thirty-two Rookies.

Congratulations go out to this year's top Rookie, Bob Worden, KD9RKG operating from Portage County. He made 293 CW QSOs for a score of 54,598.

#### Single Op Fixed (SOF)

The best score in the Single Operator Fixed category is Steve Dubberstein, K9WO, operating from Columbia County. He logged 170,030 points on 685 total Q's. In second place was Clint Sprott, W9AV, operating from Dane County with 136,108 points and 652 QSOs. Congratulations to Steve and Clint and the 144 in-Wisconsin SOF entries.

#### Multi-Op Fixed (MOF)

The MOF category had nine entries this year with first place being awarded Bruce Richardson and Janice Hoettels, W9FZ and KA9VVQ operating from Vernon County. They turned in 109,825 points on 529 Q's.

In second place is Kent and Scott Scheuerell, K9ZMU and N9HDE scoring 103,697.5 points on 458 Q's. They operated from Grant County.

Congratulations to both of you and all nine MOF category groups.

#### Multi-Multi Fixed (MMF)

Three teams entered the MMF category in 2024. The top spot in this category goes to Bob Schmidt's, N9GMT, FM38 Repeater Group operating from Green Lake County. They scored 249,694 points on 958 Q's. The FM38 Repeater Group included Bob Schmidt, N9GMT, Chris Rozman, KD9JAI, Dave Gates, K9DEG, Steve Sundquist, N9FSE, Noah Basting, NI9F, Anthony Casciato Jr., KX3H, and Keith Basting, N9LBO.

Second place in the category was Tom Baden, AC9BJ, Matt Okeson-Harlow, NM9O, and Barry Arneson, K8SD, operating W9S. They scored 127,151 points on 580 Q's from Dane County.

#### Single-Op Mobile (SOM)

Twenty-five mobiles participated in the Wisconsin QSO party this year, twenty-two SOM, one MOM, and two MMM. The first place SOM was Mark Seyffer, KB9S, with a dominating 187,424 points on 881 Q's operating from 16 counties. Following Mark was Patrick Cain, K0PC, with 180,346 points on 914 Q's operating from 16 counties as well.

Special thanks to the Minnesota mobiles for returning to Wisconsin this year, minus the poor winter driving conditions experienced last year, to again cover the Northwestern counties for us.

#### Multi-Op Mobile (MOM)

The WO9B team turned in a strong score of 168,112 points on 704 Q's. The crew included Mike Johnson, WO9B, Michael Falk, AA9RK, and Frank Humpal, KA9FZR and operated from 16 counties.

#### Multi-Multi Mobile (MMM)

Dave White, KZ9V and Michael Martens, KB9VBR operated MMM from 5 Northwestern Wisconsin counties using the call sign K9M. They completed 977 Q's for 168,224 points, winning first place.

Second place was secured by the Northeast Wisconsin Amateur Radio Club, K9TIT. The K9TIT team included Tim Hale, KC9FSH and Andrew Skjoldager, KC9IZF. They made 124 Q's for a score of 13,300 points in 8 counties.

#### Top Non-Wisconsin Single-Op

David Pritchard, W9QL, from Illinois is this year's out of state winner for the third consecutive year. With 266 Q's and 32,619 points, David placed first in a competitive challenge. In second place was another Illinois operator, Pete Walter, K9PW. Pete came in with a score of 31,218.5 points on 234 Q's and has taken second place for two consecutive years. The logs from outside Wisconsin increased this year, reversing the previous two-year trend. The Wisconsin QSO party enjoys the growth with out of state participants and hopes that the peak solar cycle brings additional operators to the party in 2025.

#### **Top QRP Station**

2024 proved to be a successful year for the QRP folks! There were 35 (9 in-state, 26 outside WI) QRP entries this year vs. 37 last year.

#### In Wisconsin

Rick McGaver, NK9G, was the top QRP station in Wisconsin with 118,444 points on 437 Q's (Milwaukee County). Thomas Russell Murphy, WN1C, was the runner up with 29,554 points on 199 Q's (Dane County).

#### Non-Wisconsin

Thomas Warren, K3TW took first place for the top QRP station outside Wisconsin with 21,220 points on 127 Q's operating from Florida. Jim smith, KK0U, had second honors with 19,016 points on 98 Q's operating from Missouri.

#### **Top VHF Station**

Forty-one logs had Q's made on 6 meters or above represented by 4 bands, 6 m, 2 m, 1.25 m, and 70 cm. The activity was primarily on two bands, 2 m (422 Q's) and 70 cm (65 Q's) and the Fox Cities Amateur Radio Club is represented by 22 of the 41 logs submitted.

First place is awarded to Joel Kasper, WI4WS, with a VHF score of 941 points from 49 Q's. Brian Long, KB9LRD, came in second with 795 points on 53 Q's.

#### Club Competition

The Driftless Zone Contesters takes top honors in the club competition this year with an aggregate score of 536,941 points. The team consisted of Mark Seyffer, KB9S, Scott Zastoupil, KX9RT, Steve Dubberstein, K9WO, and Pete Klotzbach, AF9FA.

The second place club is the Minnesota Wireless Association with 465,429.5 points contributed by 7 members operating from within Wisconsin.

#### W9FK Bonus

The W9FK bonus stations were active on phone and CW this year. Special thanks go out to Phil Gural, W9NAW, and Mike Lawrence, N9UA. Mike's CW station was fixed from Winnebago County and Phil's phone station was a portable operation from Langlade County. A total of 488 Q's were made, 450 on CW and 38 on phone. Thank you, Mike and Phil, for handing out the bonus station points!

#### Log Submissions

If you haven't been submitting your log, please reconsider. We want your logs!

We are nearly at 100% electronic submission with the three most used programs being N1MM Logger+ (47%), N3FJP (37%), and the WA7BNM Cabrillo Web Form (8%). Reporting the results from over 500 logs with detailed analysis at 6 weeks after the submission deadline would not be possible without your support of electronic log submission. Thank you!



W1WBB	It is a real challenge to be very competitive in this event within the out-of-state category from as far away as I am (850 mi from my W1-land QTH to Milwaukee) because in-state WI participants are hunting WI counties too, so lots of in-state and nearby-WI activity occurs on 40m and 80m which don't even open to W1 until much later in the day. In fact, checking the detailed WIQP historical records shows the highest score ever from a New England station was just under 25,000 pts back in 2014 (W1END in NH), which is *less than half the points of the out-of-state record*! And with record levels of out-of-state participants these days it is more challenging to break pile-ups when chasing the mobiles, especially running low power as I do. goal was just to extend the W1-land high score to as much over 25k points as I could muster. Mission accomplished! Well done to Mark K1RO in NH who also exceeded 25k total points from W1-land as well this year. Perhaps the organizers will consider creating an out-of-state *regional* record high score listing in the future. on 20m and 15m for hours with big signals, perhaps thanks to being near the peak of this solar cycle and having a quiet K-Index of 2 or less for 24 hours prior to and during the contest. But there were very few stations from WI who actually moved to 15m, which remains typical of most operators in the QPs (even with the many "band is open" notifications from the spotting network). But 20m did net me just under 100 QSOs alone! Even with low power I could be fairly competitive in the mobile pile-ups therebut NOT on 40m or 80m vs the closer-in W0/W9/W8 stations. after 3 hours into this 7-hour event and 80m was only usable for me after the final hour had begun. Both bands were relatively quiet on this end but the 80m WI sigs were not yet very strong. and SSB to keep me busy for the 6.2 hrs I was activeTU mobiles/rovers!! State in the 2024 WIQP!
