



# Wisconsin QSO Party

## 2025 Results



### Summary

Terrestrial weather for the WI QSO party was very good to excellent state-wide. The solar weather could have been better, but was it was not terrible. Compared to last year, 20 meters and above did not open to the same degree. Consequently, we did see a drop in log submissions for 2025. 468 logs were received compared to 532 last year. Submissions from outside Wisconsin totaled 298, a decrease from 334 and in-state submissions amount to 170, a decrease from 198 in 2024. Both in-state and out-of-state submissions contributed to the overall decrease. Thanks to the mobiles for their activations with a special call-out to the Minnesota mobiles for assisting with activating the sparsely populated Northwestern counties.


## Plaque Winners

## **WIQP 2025**

468 logs were received, down 12% over 2024. Wisconsin stations submitted 170 logs, down 16%. Non-Wisconsin stations submitted 298 logs, down 11%.



## County Activation

Logs received reported QSOs sent from 64 of Wisconsin's 72 counties. No logs were received from stations operating in Crawford, Florence, Forest, Iron, Marinette, Menominee, Oneida, or Rusk counties. 71 counties have reports of QSOs logged. Rusk County was absent of any reported QSOs. 49 states had QSO activity, missing only Hawaii. Additionally, seven DX logs were received representing France, Germany, Lithuania, Norway, Poland, Slovak Republic, and US Virgin Islands.



Nineteen counties were activated by mobiles only—same as 2024. The 19 mobile counties were—Adams, Ashland, Bayfield, Clark, Eau Claire, Jackson, Juneau, Keweenaw, Langlade, Lincoln, Monroe, Pepin, Pierce, Polk, Sawyer, Shawano, Taylor, Trempealeau, and Walworth.

Mobiles have characterized the Wisconsin QSO party and continue to make it the event it is today. Thanks to all 22 mobiles for participating this year!

### Activity by Band

The in-state propagation on 40 and 80 meters is correlating well with the solar cycle. Their performance mirrored last year's, suggesting a broader maximum peak than we saw in cycle 24.

### **Category Results**



### Single Op Rookie (SOR)

Nineteen Rookie logs were received from Wisconsin stations this year compared to twenty-two last year. Five Rookie logs were received from outside the state giving us a total of twenty-four Rookies.

Congratulations go out to this year's top Rookie, Ron Goote, W9RWG, operating from Walworth County. He made 520 Phone QSOs for a score of 76,260.

### Single Op Fixed (SOF)

The best score in the Single Operator Fixed category is Clint Sprott, W9AV, operating from Dane County. He logged 142,214 points on 651 total Q's. In second place was Gary Sutcliffe, W9XT, operating from Washington County with 111,171 points and 431 QSOs. Congratulations to Clint and Gary and the 125 in-Wisconsin SOF entries.

### Multi-Op Fixed (MOF)

The MOF category had seven entries this year with first place being awarded to Donna and Gil Van Blaricom, WB9TFF and WB9TFH operating from Waushara County. They turned in 61,653 points on 361 Q's.

In second place is Thomas Baden and Barry Arneson, AC9BJ and K8SD scoring 60,460 points on 351 Q's. They operated from Lafayette County.

Congratulations to both of you and all seven MOF category groups.

### Multi-Multi Fixed (MMF)

Four teams entered the MMF category this year. The top spot in this category goes to Bob Schmidt's, N9GMT, FM38 Repeater Group operating from Green Lake County. They scored 172,496 points on 856 Q's. The FM38 Repeater Group included Bob Schmidt, N9GMT, Chris Rozman, KD9JAI, Dave Gates, K9DEG, Steve Sundquist, N9FSE, Anthony Casciato Jr., KX3H, Jeffrey Rhine, N9IHC, and John Peterman, W9VG.

Second place in the category was won by Riverland Amateur Radio club, W9UP. Operators were Daniel Abts, AB9TS, Drew Neve, AB9NE, Michael G. McCarty, KB9HV, Michael T. McCarty, KE5RJJ, Lisa McCarty, KE9APN, Scott Cross, KB3MKD, Ricky Kolter, KD9GVS, Ronald Severson, KD9OHQ, Robert Mullin, KG7SDC/W9LUP, and Amos Magnuson, KE9AHQ. They scored 108,430 points on 497 Q's from Vernon County.

### Single-Op Mobile (SOM)

Twenty-two mobiles participated in the Wisconsin QSO party this year, eighteen SOM, two MOM, and two MMM. The first place SOM was Patrick Cain, K0PC, with 215,114 on 894 Q's operating from 17 counties. Following Patrick was Scott Zastoupil, KX9RT, with 157,311 points on 646 Q's operating from 15 counties.

### Multi-Op Mobile (MOM)

The WO9B team turned in a strong score of 162,950 points on 735 Q's. The crew included Mike Johnson, WO9B, Michael Falk, AA9RK, Max Falk, KD9NZB, and Frank Humpal, KA9FZR and operated from 18 counties.

Second place was won by Bruce Richardson, W9FZ, and Janice Hoettels, KA9VVQ. They logged 184 Q's racking up 16,352 points from 5 counties.

### Multi-Multi Mobile (MMM)

Dave White, KZ9V and Michael Martens, KB9VBR operated MMM from 4 Northwestern Wisconsin counties using the call sign K9M. They completed 663 Q's for 108,959 points in 4 counties, winning first place.

Second place was secured by the Northeast Wisconsin Amateur Radio Club, K9TIT. The K9TIT team included Tim Hale, KC9FSH and Andrew Skjoldager, KC9IZF. They made 142 Q's for a score of 15,289 points in 9 counties.

### Top Non-Wisconsin Single-Op

Mark Wilson, K1RO, from New Hampshire is this year's out of state winner with 248 Q's and 37,732 points. In second place was David Pritchard, W9QL from Illinois. David came in with a score of 34,910 points on 270 Q's. Log volume from outside Wisconsin decreased this year. A contributing factor was likely a somewhat less supportive 20 meters. We hope to continue to grow the out-of-state participation for 2026.

### Top QRP Station

QRP participation remained strong for 2025! There were 31 (7 in-state, 24 outside WI) QRP entries this year vs. 35 last year.

#### In Wisconsin

Rick McGaver, NK9G, was the top QRP station in Wisconsin with 94,384 points on 336 Q's (Milwaukee County). Dan Alwin, KE0TT, was the runner up with 28,712 points on 117 Q's (mobile).

#### Non-Wisconsin

Jim Smith, KK0U, took first place for the top QRP station outside Wisconsin with 28,184 points on 132 Q's operating from Missouri. Joel Kluender, W9JFK, had second honors with 19,500 points on 141 Q's operating from Michigan.

### Top VHF Station

Forty-one logs had Q's made on 6 meters or above represented by 5 bands, 6 m, 2 m, 1.25 m, 70 cm, and 23cm. The activity was primarily on two bands, 2 m (607 Q's) and 70 cm (173 Q's) and the Fox Cities Amateur Radio Club is represented by 25 of the 41 logs submitted.

First place is awarded to Dustin Berg, WI9SKY, with a VHF score of 2819 points from 78 Q's. Karen McDonald, KC9BMH, came in second with 1,004 points on 56 Q's.

### Club Competition

The Driftless Zone Contesters takes top honors in the club competition again this year with an aggregate score of 363,059 points. The team consisted of Mark Seyffer, KB9S, Scott Zastoupil, KX9RT, Steve Dubberstein, K9WO, Thomas Murphy, WN1C, and Gerald Radtke, WA9GON.

## Phone Only Plaque Competition

New for 2025 is the Highest Score in Wisconsin Phone Only plaque sponsored by Wolf River Coils. There were 112 qualified entries for the race. First place went to KC Ross, KG9JP, with a score of 85,294.5 on 563 QSO's. KC ran single-operator-fixed from Winnebago County. In second place was Ron Goote, W9RWG, with 76,260 points on 520 QSO's. Ron ran from Walworth County as single-operator-rookie.

## DX Plaque Competition

There were 7 entries for the Highest DX Score in the Wisconsin QSO Party. Laszlo Vegh, OM2VL, turned in an impressive score of 19,018 points on 137 CW Q's, 47 Phone Q's, for a total of 184 Q's with 58 mults. Laszlo operated from the Slovak Republic. Dietmar Kasper, DL3DXX, came in second with a score of 4,076 points on 51 CW QSO's with 38 mults. Dietmar operated from Germany.

## W9FK Bonus

The W9FK bonus stations were active on phone and CW this year. Special thanks go out to Phil Gural, W9NAW, and Mike Lawrence, N9UA. Mike's CW station was fixed from Winnebago County and Phil's phone station was fixed in Waukesha County. A total of 516 Q's were made, 393 on CW and 123 on phone. Thank you, Mike and Phil, for handing out the bonus station points!

## Log Submissions

If you haven't been submitting your log, please reconsider. We want your logs!

We are nearly at 100% electronic submission with the three most used programs being N1MM Logger+ (48%), N3FJP (36%), and the WA7BNM Cabrillo Web Form (6%). Publishing timely results would not be possible without your support of electronic log submission. Thank you!
